## Example:

4 in 10 mothers in India believe they should *withhold* fluids if their child has diarrhoea. This false belief contributes to 1000 child deaths from dehydration in India *every day*.

Lack of healthcare information contributes to tens of thousands of deaths every day worldwide, across *all* areas of health care.
